

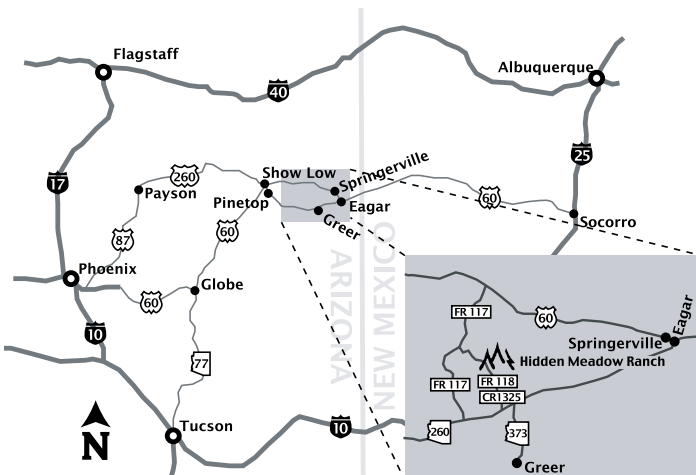


## HIDDEN MEADOW RANCH *Overview*



**Hidden Meadow Ranch is an exclusive, luxury hideaway in Arizona's White Mountains.**

Hidden Meadow Ranch is located at an elevation of 8500 feet within the two-million-acre Apache-Sitgreaves National Forest of eastern Arizona. The lodge is a 3-1/2 to 4-hour drive from Phoenix, and Tucson, slightly longer from Albuquerque and is accessible by commuter air through the Show Low Airport (approximately 45 minutes from the lodge). Charter and private aircraft may fly into the Springerville Airport, just 25 minutes from the lodge. Transportation may be arranged to the ranch from either airport.



### **GUEST CABIN FEATURES**

- Ten individually conceived and handpeeled log guest cabins of approximately 900 SF each
- Sitting area with wood-burning stone fireplace and luxurious leather furnishings

- Winding wooden staircase leading to a loft bedroom/sitting area
- Master bedroom downstairs
- Luxury bed linens
- Powder room and separate bath area with slate countertops downstairs
- Galley kitchen with microwave, mini-refrigerator, bar sink and coffeemaker
- Covered porch overlooking the meadow
- Evening turndown service, firewood delivery & in-room dining

### **LODGING FEES**

Nightly rates start at \$500 per night, double occupancy, including three gourmet meals per day and all ranch-sponsored activities. Rates adjust by the season.

### **AMENITIES**

- Expansive main Ranch House with dining, lounge and library
- Two seatings for dinner: early for families with young children and later for adults
- Casually elegant mountain grill serving three gourmet meals per day
- Full concierge service
- Horseback riding on ranch horses as well as limited boarding for guest horses with prior arrangement
- Currently, two pet-friendly cabins available with attached dog runs
